Abstract Submission Guidelines

Title: (Concise and descriptive, reflecting the core findings or argument)

Author(s): Authors should leave sufficient space in the abstract to add authors' names and affiliations. DO NOT ENTER THE NAMES OF AFFILIATION DURING INITIAL SUBMISSION

Keywords: (3-5 relevant keywords for indexing and search)

Abstract Body: (Concise and informative, should be written as one paragraph with up to 350 words.)

Background/Introduction: (~ 50 words) Briefly introduce the research problem or topic. o Explain the context and significance of the study.

Objectives/Aims/Purpose: (~50 words) Clearly state the research question or objective(s).

Methods: (~100 words) Describe the research design, participants (if applicable), data collection methods, and analytical techniques. Be concise, but give enough information to understand the general method used.

Results/Findings: (~ 100 words) Summarize the key findings or results of the study. o Use specific data or quantitative measures whenever possible.

Conclusions/Implications: (~50 words) State the main conclusions drawn from the results. Discuss the implications of the findings for the field or practice. What does your research add to the current understanding of the subject?
