

iPURSE2026 Presentation Guidelines

Peradeniya University International Research Symposium and Exposition (iPURSE2026)

These guidelines apply to all presenting authors. Please read the section relevant to your presentation type carefully and comply with all deadlines and formatting requirements.

A. Oral Presentation Guidelines

Presentation Duration

- Maximum presentation time: 10 minutes.
- Questions and discussion will be held after all presentations in the session have concluded.
- Please rehearse your presentation to ensure it fits comfortably within the allocated time.

Presentation Upload

- Upload your final presentation (Microsoft PowerPoint or PDF) using the conference Google Form no later than 6:00 PM on 19 August 2026.
- File naming convention: Oral_IDXXX_DayY_SessionZ_TrackXX_RoomY.ppt (or .pdf).
- Example: Oral_ID001_Day1_Session1_Track1.1_RoomA.ppt.

Before Your Session

- Refer to the latest Technical Programme on the conference website to confirm your Day, Session, Track and Room.
- Minor changes to sessions, rooms or timings may occur; therefore, check the programme regularly before the conference.
- Arrive at your assigned room at least 15 minutes before the session starts.
- Remain in the session until the joint discussion at the end.

Important Information

- Upload only the final version of your presentation.
- Presentation files on USB flash drives or other portable storage devices will NOT be accepted. This policy is intended to protect conference computers from malware and to ensure all presentations are preloaded and tested before the sessions.
- If you need to update your presentation before the deadline, use the 'Edit response' link in the Google Forms confirmation email.

B. Poster Presentation Guidelines

Presentation Format

- Poster presentations will be conducted as short oral presentations.
- Maximum presentation time: 5 minutes.
- Questions and discussion will be held jointly after all presentations in the session.

E-Poster Preparation

- Prepare the poster as a single Microsoft PowerPoint slide in 4:3 landscape orientation.
- All text, figures, tables and images must fit on a single slide.
- Do not use animations, transitions or embedded videos.
- Use clear visuals, high-contrast colours and readable fonts (Times New Roman, Calibri, Verdana or Arial, minimum 14 pt).
- Clearly display the Abstract ID, Title and Author(s).
- Include a conflict of interest statement and acknowledge research sponsors where applicable.
- Maximum file size: 20 MB.

Presentation Upload

- Upload the final poster (PowerPoint or PDF) using the conference Google Form no later than 6:00 PM on 19 August 2026.
- File naming convention: Poster_IDXXX_DayY_SessionZ_TrackX.X_RoomY.ppt (or .pdf).
- Example: Poster_ID001_Day1_Session1_Track1.1_RoomA.ppt.
